

2009 Kits for Church World Service and IMA World Health

Please do not include the shipping fee in the kit but deliver it to the Money Booth at the Festival of Sharing or mail it to the Festival Office. Please note on the memo line of the check that it is for CWS shipping or include a note to let us know it is for CWS shipping expenses or the Safe motherhood kit.

EMERGENCY CLEAN-UP BUCKET

These kits enable people to begin the overwhelming job of cleaning up after a disaster here in the United States.

\$45 value

1 five-gallon bucket with re-sealable lid
1 dry laundry detergent, 50-78 oz.
1 box heavy-duty trash bags, 22-27 count (33-45 gallon)
bottle liquid concentrated house-hold cleaner (i.e. Lysol®), 12 oz.
1 bottle liquid antibacterial dish soap, (like Dawn®), 25 oz.
Clothesline, two 50 ft. or one 100 ft.
18 cleaning towels, (reusable, like Easy Wipes®)
1 bottle insect repellent (drops or lotion, not aerosol) 6-14 oz.

1 pair work gloves
2 pairs latex gloves
1 scrub brush
7 sponges, assorted sizes
5 scouring pads
50 clothes pins
5 dust masks

Shipping—\$3/kit

Please purchase all liquids in plastic bottles. Send only new, unopened materials. Make sure lids on bottles are tightly closed. Put all items in the plastic bucket, making sure they are packed securely to avoid damage during shipment. Seal closed with lid.

HEALTH KIT

In the face of natural disasters, violence, or poverty, these kits can mean the difference between sickness and health for family members.

\$12 value

1 hand towel
1 washcloth
1 toothbrush (in original packaging)

1 sturdy comb
6 Band-Aids

1 metal nail file or nail clipper with file
1 bar of soap (bath size in wrapper)

Shipping—\$2/kit

Seal all items in a one-gallon plastic bag with zipper closure. Toothpaste will be added by Church World Service.

SCHOOL KIT

These kits give children in impoverished schools and refugee camps some basic tools for learning.

\$13 value

1 pair blunt child's scissors
6 new pencils with erasers

1 box of 24 crayons
1 pencil sharpener

1- 30-centimeter ruler (12")
1 large eraser

Spiral or tape-bound notebooks of ruled paper, 8-1/2" x 11" containing a total 210-270 sheets. No filler paper, please
1- 12"x14" finished size, cloth bag with cloth handles. Closure no longer required - canvas bags can be made or purchased for around \$1 at : http://www.myshopangel.com/promotional_tote_bags_economy.htm

Place the items in the bag. Place kits in a sturdy box and label with type of kit and number.

Shipping—\$2/kit

LAYETTE

Layettes provide gentle warmth for infants and basic tools for young mothers struggling with poverty or the consequences of natural disaster.

\$39 value

6 cloth diapers
2 washcloths
2 receiving blankets (1 can be a knitted blanket)

2 diaper pins
2 gowns or sleepers

2 shirts
1 sweater or sweatshirt

Shipping—\$2/kit

Bundle items inside one receiving blanket and secure with diaper pins.



Safe Motherhood Kit

These kits are for women living in developing countries. More than 50 million women give birth at home annually without the help of a trained professional or serial birthing supplies. Increasing the mortality rate of the infant and the mother.

1 Receiving Blanket
1 Jacket or tunic (a pattern can be found at this website,
http://www.interchurch.org/resources/uploads/files/168Baby_Layette_Pattern.pdf)

Other items and Shipping \$15 / kit

Place the three items in a zip lock bag. Items can be handmade or purchased. The other items for the kit will be added by IMA World Health. To complete the kit IMA needs \$15 for providing sterile birthing supplies and for shipping. The Safe Motherhood Kit developed by IMA World Health is designed to improve the chance for a safe delivery. The Kits are being channeled through the health system and made available at health clinics.

2009 Missouri Packs

Readin' & Writin' Pack - Pack Value \$12.00

6 new pencils with erasers
1 pair of child-sized metal scissors
2 spiral or tape bound notebooks (total 140 pages)

2" eraser
1 pencil holder

2 ink pens (medium point)
12" ruler

1 box of 24 crayons
6 folders with pockets

Place smaller items inside the pencil holder. Place all items in a 2 gallon zip lock bag. Place kits in boxes labeled "Readin' & Writin' Pack" and mark the **quantity** on outside of **each box**.

Paper Products Pack - Pack Value \$14.00

2 pkgs toilet tissue (4- double rolls)
Place all items in a tall-sized kitchen trash bag. Close securely and placed bagged kits in a box labeled "Paper Products Pack." Mark the **quantity** on **each box**.

3 rolls paper towels (good quality)
2 facial tissue (large rectangular boxes)

Baby Bundle Pack - Pack Value \$34.00

2 receiving blankets
2 sleepers (1 piece or gown)

2 undershirts or onesies
8-12 diapers (cloth or disposable)

1 sweater or sweatshirt for warmth
2 diaper pins (if cloth diapers are enclosed)

Please send newborn to six month sized items. Place items in a 2 gallon zip lock bag and then pack the filled bags in boxes labeled "Baby Bundles." Please mark the **quantity** of kits on the outside or **each box**.

Student Dental Pack - Pack Value \$ 11.00

1 fluoride toothpaste, 6 oz. or more
Place items inside a **1-gallon zip lock bag**. Pack filled zip locks in boxes labeled "Student Dental Packs" and mark the **quantity** on the outside of **each box**. The extra brushes are for family members.

4 child Size soft toothbrush
2 adult soft toothbrushes

1 dental floss—any size

Family Food Pack - Pack Value \$37.00

6 cans assorted vegetables
2 pounds pasta
2 pounds dried pinto beans

6 cans assorted fruits
2 jars peanut butter
6 packages macaroni & cheese

6 cans tuna
2 cans Spam

2 cans pasta sauce
2 pounds rice

Place items in a sturdy box or book carton, tape and label "Family Food Pack."

Personal Hygiene Pack - Pack Value \$ 20.00

1 fluoride toothpaste, 6 oz. or more
1 bath-size bar of soap
1 hand towel
1 comb **or** brush

1 washcloth
1 deodorant
1 bottle shampoo (11—14 oz)

1 toothbrush in original, unopened pkg.
1 bottle skin lotion (11—14 oz)
2 disposable razors

Tighten lids and place all items in a **large zip lock bag (2-gallon size works best)**. Place zip locks in boxes labeled "Personal Hygiene Pack." Please also mark the **quantity** on the outside of **each box**.

Prison Pack - Pack Value \$ 9.00

1 Emery Board (**not a metal nail file**)
30 sheets of writing paper, 6"x9", (**no note cards**)
1 Shampoo (12-16 oz. size, alcohol-free only) *Acceptable brands: Suave, Equate Herbal, Personal Care Herbal, Alberto VO5, Style
1 Tube toothpaste (6 - 6.4 oz. size, alcohol-free only) *Acceptable brands: All types of Ultrabrite, Colgate, Crest, Aquafresh and Gleem
1 Deodorant (2-3 oz. size, alcohol-free only, no roll-ons, no men's brands) *Acceptable brands: Revlon Hi & Dri, Lady Mitchum Clean Gel, Crystal Clean Deodorant, Almay Clear Gel, Simple Basic Clear Deodorant

1 Pencil (unsharpened, no advertising)
5 Envelopes (white standard size, not business size)

Place only these items in a plastic bag. Put filled bags in boxes labeled "Prison Pack." Please also label with the **number** enclosed.

Toothbrushes and Stamps are not allowed as part of these kits.

Backpacks of Love - Pack Value \$40.00

1 small backpack or small duffel (**NO backpacks with wheels**)
1 t-shirt (Child Medium, Child Large or Adult Small)
1 pair socks
1 youth toothbrush (soft and in unopened, original package)
1 coloring book (for age 4-7) or 1 notebook (for age 8-11)
1 travel pillow

1 small stuffed animal
1 pkg. - 3 pair underpants
1 narrow tooth comb
1 tube child flavored toothpaste, 6 oz. or more
1 box crayons (for age 4-7) or 1 pencil (for age 8-11)

A small quilt or blanket already donated will be added to the kit. **Please pack all items in the backpack and label the box "Backpacks"**. These kits are used by children between the ages of 4 to 11 who have experienced a crisis and are being placed in foster care.

Youth Hygiene Pack - Pack Value \$40.00

1 3 oz bottle hand sanitizer
1 Calendar / address book
1 travel pillow
1 deodorant
1 travel size conditioner
1 toothbrush
1 men's body spray OR 1 small package of feminine pads or tampons

3 ink pens
1 journal
1 fleece throw
1 travel size shampoo
1 travel size lotion
1 travel size toothpaste

1 small permanent marker (for personalization of bag)
1 chap stick
1 washcloth
1 travel size hair gel / hair spray (non aerosol)
1 pocket pack of tissue
1 box medicated facial cleansing pads (such as Stridex)

Put all the items in a drawstring bag approximately 15" X 22". Please use solid color fabric to allow the teen to personalize the bag. All items should be placed inside the bag with the draw string pulled. Place kits in a box and label "Youth Pack" and the number of packs in the box. These kits are used by children between the ages of 12 to 18 who have experienced a crisis and are being placed in state care.
